Resolution 20-03, Full Top Five at Regional Shows and Rides Regardless of Entries was adopted in 2003 and became effective January 1, 2004 with the following resolves: "That commencing in 2004, all AHA Regional Championship Horse Shows, Regional Championship Endurance Rides, Regional Championship Competitive Trail Rides, may elected to award all Top Five ribbons in every class and ride, no matter how many entries per class or ride compete. All Top Five Awards awarded shall include qualifications, and all other AHA program benefits with the exception of International Arabian Breeders Sweepstakes and the AHA Horse Achievement Award Program, Amateur Achievement Award Program, High Point Horse Achievement Award Program, High Point Amateur Achievement Award Program, Distance Horse Program, which shall remain as is.;" That Article 1320.2 shall be revised as follows: Regional Shows, Regional Championship Endurance Rides and Regional Championship Competitive Trail Rides may elect to present Top Five Awards in all classes regardless of how many entries are competing at the close of the gate. Top Five Awards may be given to all rides regardless of how many horses are in each division.
