PERFORMANCE FUTURITY/MATURITY/DERBY PROGRAM INFORMATION Refer to Chapter 20 of the AHA Handbook regarding additional program information and payout

Payment must be submitted with the Performance Futurity/Maturity/Derby Enrollment Application.

Entries submitted without payment are subject to late fees.

Enrollment into the program does not constitute entry into the U.S. National Championship Show. A separate U.S. National Show Entry form must be submitted with the appropriate entry fees prior to the close of entries in order for the horse to be shown in the Performance Futurity/Maturity/Derby Class. Program enrollment(s) can be sent to info.comp@arabianhorses.org or faxed to 303-696-4599.

A horse that is co-owned by two distinct non-family members *cannot* be shown in Maturity AAO Classes at the U.S. National Championship Show as per USEF AR 110.

Enrollment fees can be made in payments as per the payment schedule or can be paid in full by the original closing date for U.S. Entries. Payments/entries received after the indicated dates are subject to additional late fees. Entries postmarked after the original close of U.S. Entries and up until the <u>first</u> Post Entry close date will be assessed an additional \$750.

<u>All nomination payments are final and non-refundable.</u> Any portion of a nomination payment not postmarked/electronic transaction dated by the due dates will cause that entry to be considered a late entry. There will be no refund of the nomination fee, any portion of a nomination fee or processing fee.

Class intent must be declared at the time of enrollment into the program (Example: I intend to compete in the Western Pleasure Maturity AAOTR).

If you determine at a later date that you horse is better suited to another discipline, you may change the class intent with a class change fee. A request to change a class postmarked/electronic transaction dated after **August 1** and prior to the **original** close of U.S. National Entries will be allowed with a written request and a \$100 class change fee (can send to AHA office or to info.comp@arabianhorses.org). A request to change classes after the original close of U.S. Entries will be allowed with a written request and a \$250 change fee up until October 1st. The class change fee will be retained by AHA for administrative fees.

Substitution of horses is prohibited.

Transfers can be made to the consecutive year for horses which are injured, provided that a written request from the recorded owner and veterinarian statement is received (submit to info.comp@arabianhorses.org) within 15 days
prior to the first day of the show. The transfer can only be applied to the same horse with a transfer fee of \$100.
Only the Performance Futurity/Maturity/Derby fees will transfer from one year to the next. A new official National Show Class Entry form with applicable fees will be required the following year.

Enrollment fees into the program <u>will not be refunded</u> if the horse is not entered and/or shown in the U.S. National Show. The fees will be paid out in prize money for the intended class for that show year.

If fewer than nineteen (19) horses are shown in the class, 50% rounded up, will be eligible for prize money.

*Half-Arabians must have DNA type of the horse and the horse's purebred Arabian parent placed on permanent record with the AHA Registry and the horse must have been shown to qualify as an offspring of the stated purebred sire or purebred dam through DNA type testing in order to compete in the Performance Futurity/Maturity/Derby Classes at the U.S. National Championship Show. DNA testing will be done at the owner's expense and must be on file with the AHA office before the horse will be eligible to compete in the Performance Futurity/Maturity/Derby Class. If the DNA is not on file at that time, the horse is ineligible to be shown and all nominations fees will be forfeited.
