

Planning Begins for the 2nd Annual Arabian U.S. Open at the Rolex Central Park Horse Show

(05-MAY-16) – AURORA, COLO. – Planning is just getting under way for the 2nd Annual Arabian U.S. Open, sponsored by Aljassimya Farm and hosted by the Arabian Horse Association (AHA), at the Rolex Central Park Horse Show.

In 2015, Arabian horses were showcased to the world on a platform with the potential to broadcast the Arabian breed into all four corners of the earth. Their debut in New York City was an exquisite one, with perfect weather, a breathtaking arena and an electric atmosphere – an evening for the record books.

2016 is the second year that the beloved Arabian breed has been invited to showcase their beauty and athleticism at this esteemed event. Located in Central Park in the middle of Manhattan, New York, on Wednesday, September 21, 2016, Arabian horses hold the coveted opening night spot at the September 21-25 event. The Rolex Central Park Horse Show is hosted by the Chronicle of the Horse and International Equestrian Group (IEG) and owner, Mark Bellissimo.

The Arabian U.S. Open 2016 schedule has changed slightly, but will include the following classes: Arabian Mounted Native Costume; Junior Fillies; Hunter Pleasure; Junior Colts; Western Pleasure; Senior Mares; Country English Pleasure; and Senior Stallions. The Hunter Pleasure, Western Pleasure and Country English Pleasure classes will be in the Pro/Am format and there will be no yearling classes. Gold, Silver and Bronze champions will be crowned once again for each class.

With the limited availability of stalls, fifty horses will attend the event. Trainers and exhibitors who participated at the show in 2015 will be given the first opportunity to attend. Additionally, at the 2015 U.S. Nationals, amateur riders who won invitations to compete with their horses at Central Park include: Afireandbrimstone SCA and Susan Knipe for Country English Pleasure; Onyx A and Anne Keller for Western Pleasure; RD Nevaska and Sheryl Yochum for Hunter Pleasure; and Beg for Mercy and Stacy Plonte for Native Costume.

Further information regarding qualifying for the available spots will be announced in the next couple of weeks. The deadline for entries is tentatively planned for July 1, 2016.

The Arabian U.S. Open will once again be held at Wollman Rink in Central Park Wednesday evening, September 21. The show will be live streamed through Arabian Horse Global and Arabian Horse Results, allowing audiences around the world to see this prestigious event.

Further information, including the host hotel, opportunities for purchasing a VIP/Patron table and detailed information for exhibitors will be available after June 1, 2016.
