Required:

Pick at least 8 of the below criteria:

1. Attend all 3 AHYA Board Meetings
2. Attend and participate in the AHYA Convention in July
3. Find at least three $\$ 250$ Qualifier T-shirt Sponsor - one additional to the two required
4. Hold and run at least two annual Regional Meetings, provide a report to AHA's Youth and Family Programs Coordinator
5. Create a written budget for your region with money set aside for travel expenses for your Regional Director to attend the AHYA Board Meetings
6. Run one outreach program that reaches individuals outside of the show ring or a distance ride. Must provide a report of this activity to AHA's Youth and Family Programs Coordinator
7. Submit three Regional Reports annually, one for each of the AHYA Board Meetings, Reports must be submitted electronically to AHA's Youth and Family Programs Coordinator before each board meeting
8. Volunteer at least 5 hours for AHYA at any of AHA's National or Regional Shows or AHA Convention.
9. Sell at least 5 Raffle Tickets
10. Be active on at least one AHYA Committee
11. Attend a public speaking seminar/class/course. Must provide proof of attendance
12. Turn in a class project that demonstrates a skill of a future leader
13. Complete 5 community service hours (non-Arabian horse related) in your local community
14. Turn in a one page report defining Robert's Rules of Order.
