Too Slow/per gait	Off Pattern
Over bridled	>Eliminates or adds maneuver >Incomplete maneuver
Out of frame	>Failure to complete the pattern as written
Break of gait at walk or trot for 2 strides or less	Unnatural Arabian Tail carriage AR105.2b (assess 1 time only)
Wrong Lead or out of lead for 2 strides or less	Zero (0) Score
Three (3) Point Penalties	Major disobedience or schooling
Break of gait at walk or trot for more than 2 strides	Prohibited use of fingers or hands on reins
Break of gait at lope, except when correcting an incorrect lead	Improper western attire (AR 211.4.b.1)
Wrong Lead or out of lead for more than 2 strides	No score (DQ)
Out of lead or cross cantering more than 2 strides when changing lead	Lameness
Draped reins	Abuse
Trotting more than 3 strides when making simple lead change	Prohibited equipment
Severe disturbance of any obstacle	Fresh blood in the mouth, nose, chin, shoulder, barrel and or hip area AR105.6
Trotting more than 3 strides in lope departures or when exiting rollback	Disrespect or misconduct
Five (5) Point Penalties	Leaving working area before pattern is complete
Blatant disobedience - kick, bite, buck, rear, etc	Fall of horse/exhibitor

No specific penalties will be incurred for nicks/hits of logs/poles or for over/under spins but deductions may be made in maneuver score

Begins with a score of 70 -1 1/2 extremely poor, -1 Very Poor, -1/2 Poor, 0 correct, +1/2 Good, +1 Very Good, +1 1/2 Excellent AR 105.2 10 Pt Penalty must be assessed for unnatural Arabian Tail Carriage
