Sport Horse In-Hand Championships and Reserve Championships will have the number in the class determined <u>by two (2) horses</u> in each lead-in class to that Championship. (See the example to the left.) No horse may be named Champions and Reserve. If the same horse has the two (2) highest scores, the next highest eligible horse will be name Reserve Champion.

The number in the Championship would be five (5).
