- Has the Foundation had an impact?
 - Research
 - The Foundation has funded projects resulting in development of direct DNA tests for Cerebellar Abiotrophy (CA) and Lavender Foal Syndrome (LFS).
 - The Foundation has also funded studies investigating the genetic basis of Equine Metabolic Syndrome (EMS), equine melanoma, Juvenile Idiopathic Epilepsy (JIE), and Occipitoatlantoaxial Malformation (OAAM).
 - Our financial support helps researchers secure Federal funding more successfully.
