25 ***The Arabian Horse Association (AHA) reciprocates in all suspensions assessed to Arabian participants by United States***  
26 ***Equestrian Federation (USEF) and Equestrian Canada (EC). Upon official notification from USEF and/or EC, AHA will***  
27 ***post those suspended (Exhibitors/Owners/Trainers/Handlers and/or horses) to the AHA website under Censures &***  
28 ***Suspensions for the length of time indicated by USEF and EC.***
