Whereas, It is the desire of Arabian Exhibitors to be judged by the most qualified judges, and
Whereas, There exists a well-qualified pool of judges from outside our breed that specialize in adjudicating Ranch Riding, and
Whereas, It would be to the benefit of AHA to ensure the non-USEF/AHA licensed judges meet the criteria set by the Judges and Stewards Commissioner and the EEC; Therefore, Be It
Resolved, That a new USEF GR1010.10.f be created by inserting the following:
f. Ranch Riding - Experienced National Reining Horse Association (NRHA) or National Reined Cow Horse Association (NRCHA) judges, also licensed in another breed (i.e. AQHA, APHA, ApHC, etc.) and/or those holding a Specialty Card with the Arabian Horse Association are allowed a Guest Card.; and, Be It Further

Resolved, That the remaining subparagraph(s) be re-lettered.
