8 **Whereas,** There has been interest expressed to expand the Select Rider classes for all Arabian Exhibitors; Therefore
9 **Be It**

11 Resolved That AR 113 be amended to the following:

12 AR113 Abbreviations of Class Specifications. [Chapter AR. Arabian Division. Subchapter AR-3 Classes]
13 Change to read:

14 1. The following abbreviations, as defined, will be used to describe class specifications in each section of
15 the Arabian Division.
16 f. SELECT - AOT, AAOT, AT, AAT, JOT, JT – Competitors in the Arabian, Half-Arabian, or Anglo-
17 Arabian Divisions shall not be considered separately when competing in the same performance or
18 breeding/halter section. If competitors are eligible to compete as a Select Rider/Driver/Handler in a section
19 on December 1, said eligibility remains throughout the current competition year. (That said eligibility is
20 determined beginning with Regional and National competitions of 1997). (Limited classes beginning in
21 2001.)

22 **Select** National Championship classes are open to competitors **that** have not won any of the following:
23 (1) i One (1) AHA National Champion, Reserve Champion or Top Ten; in that particular section in which
24 they are shown. As an example Western Pleasure, Hunter Pleasure, Country English Pleasure, English
25 Pleasure and Breeding/In-Hand are each separate sections.
26 (2) ii One (1) AHA National Champion or Reserve Champion in a Select class in that particular section in
27 which they are shown.
28 (3) iii Three (3) AHA National Top Ten in a Select class in which they are shown.
29 ~~(4) iv One (1) AHA Regional Champion, Reserve Champion or three (3) Top Fives in that particular~~
30 ~~section in which they are shown.~~

32 ~~Qualifying and Select~~ Regional Championship classes are open to a rider/driver/handler that has not won
33 any of the following:
34 (1) i One (1) AHA National Champion or Reserve Champion or Top Ten in that particular section in which
35 they are shown.
36 (2) ii One (1) AHA National Champion or Reserve Champion in a Select class in that particular section in
37 which they are shown.
38 (3) iii Three (3) AHA National Top Tens in a Select class in that particular section in which they are
39 shown.
40 (4) iv One (1) AHA Regional Champion, Reserve Champion or three (3) Top Fives in that particular
41 section in which they are shown.
42 (5) v Two (2) AHA Regional Champion in a Select Class in that particular section in which they are
43 shown.

45 National and Regional Classes with 2 or less entries will not effect Select rider status.

47 (2) Select Rider/Driver/Handler classes may be offered in any section of the Arabian Division. If not
48 specifically addressed within each section, class(es) must run under AT, AAT, JT, AOT, AAOT, or JOT
49 specifications.
50 (3) Competitors in the Arabian, Half-Arabian, or Anglo-Arabian Divisions shall not be considered
51 separately when competing in the same section. If a competitor is eligible to compete as a Select in a
52 section on December 1, said eligibility remains throughout the current competition year (that eligibility is
53 determined beginning with Regional and National competitions of 1997).
