Whereas, There is a need to continue to perform outreach to the general public to invite them to join the Arabian Horse Community, and

Whereas, The majority of the outreach comes from AHA clubs,
Whereas, The clubs provide an atmosphere to join together with like minded individuals, and
Whereas, The number of clubs across North American is declining as well as the size of many of the clubs, and
Whereas, Without a strong club structure, the Arabian exposure to bring in new owners \& riders cannot flourish
Whereas, Without a strong club structure, there will be no one to put on the local shows and rides, and
Whereas, Some individuals wish to belong to more than one AHA club to participate in each individual club's opportunities and

Whereas, Many individuals have gone to internet clubs to support a specific discipline, trainers, distance, etc. which has greatly affected the size of the local clubs, and

Whereas, The most successful clubs that put on events have a variety in the type of their members to include trainers, amateurs, exhibitors, youth and Arabian enthusiasts, and

Whereas In the proponents opinion, AHA should promote club memberships by making it easier and less expensive to participate in multiple clubs both Local and Internet, Therefore be it

Resolved, That MEM 104 GENERAL RULES FOR MEMBERSHIP be amended by inserting a new Paragraph 8
8. An Adult Individual member may join more than one club by having the member declare one club as their original club and any other club(s) as additional club(s) and receive a discount of $\$ 25$ for each club after the original one for a 1 year membership.
a. The end date for the memberships shall be that of the original club, except for individual with life membership, their additional club memberships shall be a calendar year,
b. The AHA member shall have full voting rights in each AHA club and
c. The member can only be a delegate for one club each year at the AHA convention, but that individual will count for each club's delegate count, and; Be It Further

Resolved, $\quad$ That the fee structure of multiple club membership will be effective on April 1, 2025

There will be a need to be a change to the sign-up process for clubs to designate one club as the original club and subsequent clubs as additional clubs. Therefore, the signup form will need to change and the back office to track one member in multiple clubs so the accounting is correct. The IT department will need time to implement the necessary changes and in the past we have always started the membership changes on the fiscal year start. IT has other projects so $4 / 1 / 24$ is not realistic. Currently approximately 204 members belong to multiple clubs and with the discount of $\$ 25$, that is a decrease of $\$ 5350$. However, in the future there is the desire for more people to join a local club and not just an internet club. Those members will be new income for AHA in the amount of $\$ 30$ for each club that they join if the membership increase is approved. In the survey to AHA members ( $33 \%$ responded), $46 \%$ said they would like to belong to multiple clubs. The $\$ 25$ is a discount of about $50 \%$ rounded to the nearest $\$ 5$ amount.
