How the Performance Futurity/Maturity/Derby Program Works

These classes are only available at U.S. Nationals and Sport Horse Nationals.

There are 3 steps in order to participate in the Performance Futurity/Maturity Classes.

1. Enrollment into the Performance Futurity/Maturity Program.
2. Entry into the corresponding Performance Futurity/Maturity Class for U.S. or Sport Horse Nationals
3. All Half-Arabians competing in the Half-Arabian Futurity/Maturity Classes must have parentage DNA verified to a purebred Arabian parent on file at the AHA office before they are allowed to compete in the class.

Owners wishing to compete in this program must enroll in the program either by making payments per the payment schedule or in or one lump sum. **Late fees may apply for any missed due dates.**

Performance Futurity/Maturity/Derby Program

Nomination into the Performance Futurity/Maturity Program does not include entry fees, post entry fees, drug fees, etc. Nomination into the Performance Futurity/Maturity Program does not constitute entry into the U.S. National Championship Show. A separate U.S. National or Sport Horse National Show Entry Form must be submitted with the appropriate fees prior to the close of entries in order for the horse to be shown in the specified Performance Futurity/Maturity Class.

A horse that is co-owned by two distinct non-family members **cannot** be shown in the Performance Maturity Program.

2022 Program Updates

Two new Performance Maturity Classes have been added for the 2022 Sport Horse National Championship Show.

- Arabian Sport Horse Under Saddle AOTR
- HA/AA Sport Horse Under Saddle AOTR

These classes are for horses that are 5-6 years old. Enrollment into the Program will serve as the qualification for the class.

Enrollment into the Performance Maturity Program does not constitute entry into the Sport Horse National Championship Show. The official Show Entry Form must be completed and submitted to the AHA office by entry close.

Note: Half-Arabians competing in the Maturity Classes must have DNA verified to the purebred Arabian Parent on file at the AHA office before they are allowed to compete.

Prize Money Payout

- All nomination fees and the \$750 and \$1,000 late fees will go into the prize money for that class.
- Prize money for each class will be distributed as follows:
 - Champion – 25%
 - Reserve Champion – 15%
 - Remaining Top Ten – 7.5%
- If fewer than nineteen horses are in the class, 50%, rounded up, will be eligible for Performance Futurity/Maturity Payout. Any remaining Top Ten money will be divided equally between all Top Ten placings.

Prize Money Payout – Continued

- Prize money will be issued to the recorded owner of the horse at the time of the show. Checks for prize money shall be mailed within 60 days after completion of the competition.
- The Social Security Number or Federal Taxpayer Identification Number and all Sweepstakes requirements must be on file for each unique owner/account with AHA before prize money is released.
- Foreign residents winning prize money at an event held in the United States will be subject to income tax of 30% per Internal Revenue Service regulations. This amount will be withheld from the total winnings.
