LAST CHANCE BUY-IN FOR SWEEPSTAKES ORIGINAL ENTRY

Q. WHAT IS THE “LAST CHANCE BUY-IN FOR SWEEPSTAKES?”

A. The “Last Chance Buy-In For Sweepstakes” is a limited time opportunity for you to enroll your horse in the Sweepstakes Program and be eligible to earn prize money. The horse will be entered as an “Original Entry” in the Arabian Breeder Sweepstakes Program.

Q. WHAT IS AN ORIGINAL ENTRY?

A. An Original Entry is open to any living horse registered with AHA or the Canadian Registries (CAHR or CPAR). This entry does not require that the horse be by a Nominated Sire or out of a Nominated Dam. They are eligible to win Allocated Prize money in Sweepstakes designated classes for the horse’s life with the exception of the Regional and National Yearling Sweepstakes halter classes.

Q. HOW DO I ENTER MY HORSE(S) AS AN ORIGINAL ENTRY?

A. The recorded owner will need to complete the Original Entry Enrollment Application and submit it to the AHA office with payment. Current AHA membership is required to enroll into the program.

Q. IS THERE A DEADLINE IN WHICH I MUST ENTER MY HORSE(S) AS AN ORIGINAL ENTRY?

A. Yes. The Last Chance Buy-In for Sweepstakes for an Original Entry is only available from January 1, 2019 through October 15, 2019. Entries postmarked/electronic transaction dated after October 15, 2019 will not be accepted.

Horses must be enrolled in the Sweepstakes Program prior to the start of a show in order to be eligible to earn prize money at that show. Retroactive enrollments will not be allowed.

Q. WHAT IS THE COST TO ENROLL MY HORSE(S)?

A. The enrollment fee will be based on the age of the horse and the number of horses you are enrolling. The age of the horse is determined by the universal January 1 date. For example, my horse was born April 15, 2015. As of January 1, 2019, he would be 4 years old.

In order to receive discounted enrollment fees, the enrollments must be submitted at the same time and by the same recorded owner. The number of horses enrolled can vary by age. Examples:

1. I have three horses to enter. One is 3 years old, one is 4 years old and one is 7 years old. I would pay \$3,000 for the 3 year old, \$4,000 for the 4 year old and \$5,000 for the 7 year old.
2. I have 5 horses to enter. Two are 3 years old, two are 5 years old and one is an 8 year old. I would pay \$2,500 for each of the 3 year olds, \$3,500 for each of the 5 year olds and \$5,000 for the 8 year old.
3. I have 10 horses to enter. Four are 3 years old, four are 4 year olds and two are 6 years old. I would pay \$2,000 for each of the 3 year olds, \$3,000 for each of the 4 year olds and \$5,000 each for the two that are 6 years old.

Q. IS THERE A PAYMENT OPTION FOR ME TO ENROLL MY HORSE(S) AS AN ORIGINAL ENTRY IN THE SWEEPSTAKES PROGRAM?

A. Yes. AHA offers a Last Chance Buy-In For Sweepstakes Original Entry Deferred Billing Agreement (LC Deferred Billing Agreement). Payment of the entry fee due for an Original Entry may be made pursuant to a LC Deferred Billing Agreement. The Original Entry Application and signed LC Deferred Billing Agreement must be submitted at the same time.

Q. I WANT TO ENROLL MY HORSE(S) AS AN ORIGINAL ENTRY. I ALSO HAVE FOALS/HORSES THAT I WANT TO ENROLL AS A BREEDING ENTRY/NOMINATED SIRE/NOMINATED DAM. CAN I USE THE DEFERRED BILLING AGREEMENT AS A OPTION FOR PAYMENT FOR ENROLLMENT INTO THE SWEEPSTAKES PROGRAM?

A. Yes. However, since the Original Entry is being offered for a limited time, you will need to submit the entries on two separate Deferred Billing Agreements. Original Entry enrollments will need to be submitted with the LC Deferred Billing Agreement. Any other type of Sweepstakes enrollments (Breeding Entry/Nominated Sire/Nominated Dam) must be submitted on the Arabian Breeders Sweepstakes Deferred Billing Agreement.

Q. ARE THERE RESTRICTIONS FOR PLACING ENTRIES ON A DEFERRED BILLING AGREEMENT?

A. Yes. Quarterly payments are made based on the total amount due for the entries. AHA charges a 10% administrative fee for entries placed on Deferred Billing. Entries totaling up to \$2,500 can be made in 4 quarterly payments. For entries that are \$2,501 and up you can choose either 4 or 8 quarterly payments. These amounts do not include the administrative fee.

If the LC Deferred Billing Agreement payment is not received within 60 days of billing date, the entry(ies) will be dropped from the program and all monies paid in and any prize money earned will be forfeited.

Q. WHEN CAN I EXPECT TO RECEIVE MY SWEEPSTAKES CHECKS?

- A.** For entries that have been paid in full, Allocated Prize money at the Regional and National Level will be issued within 60 days of receipt of completed results.

Prize money earned at the Regional and National level by entries that were placed on the LC Deferred Billing Agreement will be applied to the outstanding balance of that LC Deferred Billing.

When prize money is earned by an Original Entry that was enrolled using the LC Deferred Billing Agreement it will be applied to the last payment first. For example, the LC Deferred Billing is set up for 4 quarterly payments. The first payment was made at the time of enrollment into the program. A horse earns \$1,000 in prize money. The \$1,000 will be applied in reverse order to the 4th payment first and then 3rd payment and so on until paid in full. If prize money is earned in excess of the outstanding balance of the LC Deferred Billing Agreement payments, a check will be issued for the difference.

Checks will be issued only to the party whose name appears on a horse's Certificate of Registration for horses registered with AHA or whose name appears on the Sweepstakes Certificate for horses registered with CAHR or CPAR during the time of the show.

Q. I HAVE SEVERAL HORSES ON ONE LC DEFERRED BILLING AGREEMENT. CAN I PAY OFF THE BALANCE OF ONE HORSE AND KEEP MAKING PAYMENTS ON THE OTHERS?

- A.** No. Individual horses cannot be removed from a LC Deferred Billing. The Last Chance Buy-In For Sweepstakes Original Entry Deferred Billing Agreement is a contract for all the horses that were enrolled using the LC Deferred Billing.

Q. WHAT CLASSES CAN I SHOW MY HORSE IN AS AN ORIGINAL ENTRY?

- A.** A horse enrolled as an Original Entry can show in Regional and National Sweepstakes designated classes. This includes the ABS Dressage Prospect Incentive and ABS Green Working Hunter Derby at Sport Horse Nationals and the Sweepstakes AAO Jackpot Classes at U.S. Nationals. A horse that is co-owned by the two distinct non family members cannot be shown in AAO Jackpot classes at any AHA National Championship Show. The Regional and National Yearling Sweepstakes halter classes are restricted to Breeding Entries only.

Q. AM I ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE BREEDER/NOMINATOR PAYBACK?

- A.** No. Only horses enrolled in-utero as Breeding Entries are eligible for Breeder/Nominator Payback.

Q. AM I ELIGIBLE FOR ANY OTHER TYPES OF DISCOUNTS?

- A.** No. Only horses enrolled as Breeding Entries are eligible to receive a discount if enrolling the horse as a Nominated Sire or Nominated Dam.

Q. WHERE CAN I FIND ENROLLMENT FORMS?
