The horse must have been entered, shown and judged in any Performance Class at U.S. Nationals, except Showmanship Class.

Reminders

Sweepstakes Yearling Classes at U.S. Nationals, Sport Horse Nationals and Canadian Nationals are restricted to Breeding Entries only.

To qualify for a U.S. National Sweepstakes Yearling Class, the Breeding Entry must have placed as a Top Ten from one of the corresponding 18 Regional Yearling Sweepstakes Classes.

The HA/AA Yearling Sweepstakes In-Hand Classes at U.S. Nationals will be paid through 2020. In 2021, they will be discontinued as Sweepstakes designated classes at U.S. Nationals.

ABS Dressage Prospect Incentive payback at Sport Horse Nationals will be restricted to horses enrolled as a Breeding Entry or Original Entry in 2021.

Only horses enrolled as a Breeding Entry or Original Entry that meet eligibility requirements will receive prize money.

Yearling Halter Classes are restricted to Sweepstakes Breeding Entries. To qualify for the U.S. National Yearling Classes, the Breeding Entry must have placed as a Top Ten from one of the 18 Regional Sweepstakes Yearling Classes.

Dressage classes can be combined as Arabian/Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian.

Regional Level: If fewer than nine horses are in the class, 50% rounded up will be eligible for prize money.

Sweepstakes AAOTR classes are eligible to be split into multiple age divisions (must be all age inclusive). Splitting AAOTR classes is not recommended as this reduces the Sweepstakes payout for each split. When Leveling AAOTR class(es) are offered for a discipline, they will receive the prize money in place of the AAOTR class(es). Should multiple AAOTR classes be offered, the class with the fewest splits will be paid. *No other Sweepstakes classes can be split. If they are split, they will not be eligible for prize money (including Junior Horse Classes).*

The 50% payout rule applies to all Sweepstakes classes (except National Yearling Classes, ABS Dressage Prospect Incentive Class, ABS Green Working Hunter Derby at Sport Horse Nationals, AAO Jackpot Classes and ABS AAO Performance Halter Classes at U.S. Nationals).

Prize money at the National and Regional shows will be paid only to the party whose name appears on a horse's Certificate of Registration for horses registered with AHA or whose name appears on the Sweepstakes Certificate for horses registered with CAHR or CPAR at the time of the show. Checks for prize money shall be mailed no later than 60 days upon receipt of complete results.

The Social Security Number of Federal Taxpayer Identification Number and all Sweepstakes requirements must be on file with AHA before prize money is released. If this information is not on file or is not provided with 120 days after notification, Sweepstakes Prize Money will be forfeited. If enrollment requirements are not fulfilled by December 31 of the calendar year following the year in which the prize money is won, the prize money shall be forfeited. Foreign residents winning prize money at an event in the United States will be subject to income tax of 20% per Internal Revenue Service regulations. The amount will be withheld from total winnings. If a prize money check is issued and not presented for payment by December 31 of the year following the year in which the prize money was won, the prize money shall be forfeited.

National Level - If fewer than nineteen horses are in the ride, 50% rounded up will be eligible for prize money.

Regional Level - If fewer than nine horses are in the ride, 50% rounded up will be eligible for prize money.

Each AHA account that receives prize money must have a W-9 on file. It is possible to have two or more AHA accounts that have unique information (i.e. horses, owners, etc.). Therefore, a separate W-9 is required for each account. It is especially important for joint accounts. Payee on a joint account have the choice of which owner will assume the tax liability and file the tax return, should one be required. The only reason a W-9 will be requested is due to the fact a Tax ID is not on file or that specific account/ownership.

***PLUS** - Each competitor will contribute \$500 to a prize money jackpot. Sweepstakes Prize Money and additional jackpot prize money will be awarded as follows: 20% to the Champion, 10% to the Reserve Champion and 8.75% to each of the remaining Top Ten. Any jackpot money not distributed shall be equally divided among all placings. Sweepstakes Prize Money not awarded will be retained in the Sweepstakes principal fund.

Arabians and Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabians 6 yrs and over may participate.

Classes are restricted to Breeding Entries and Original Entries.

Open to 4 and 5 year old Sweepstakes and non-Sweepstakes horses. Sweepstakes nominated Breeding Entries and Original Entries and are the only horses eligible for Sweepstakes payback. This class will be closed to non-Sweepstakes horses in the 2021 competition year.

Horses must be enrolled as a Breeding Entry or Original Entry in order to be shown in these classes. The horse must have been entered, shown and judged in any Performance Class at U.S. Nationals. Showmanship Classes do not count as Performance Classes. Performance Halter Rules, specifications and procedures will be strictly enforced, including the use of the Performance Halter Scorecard.
