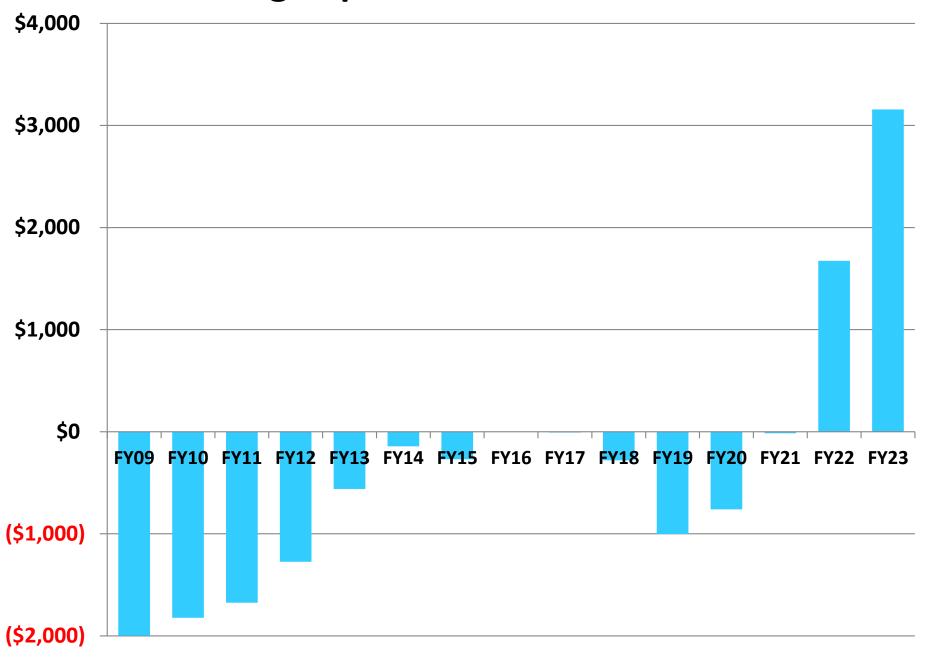
Working capital does not include Sweepstakes & Futurities program cash -- only operations cash is included.

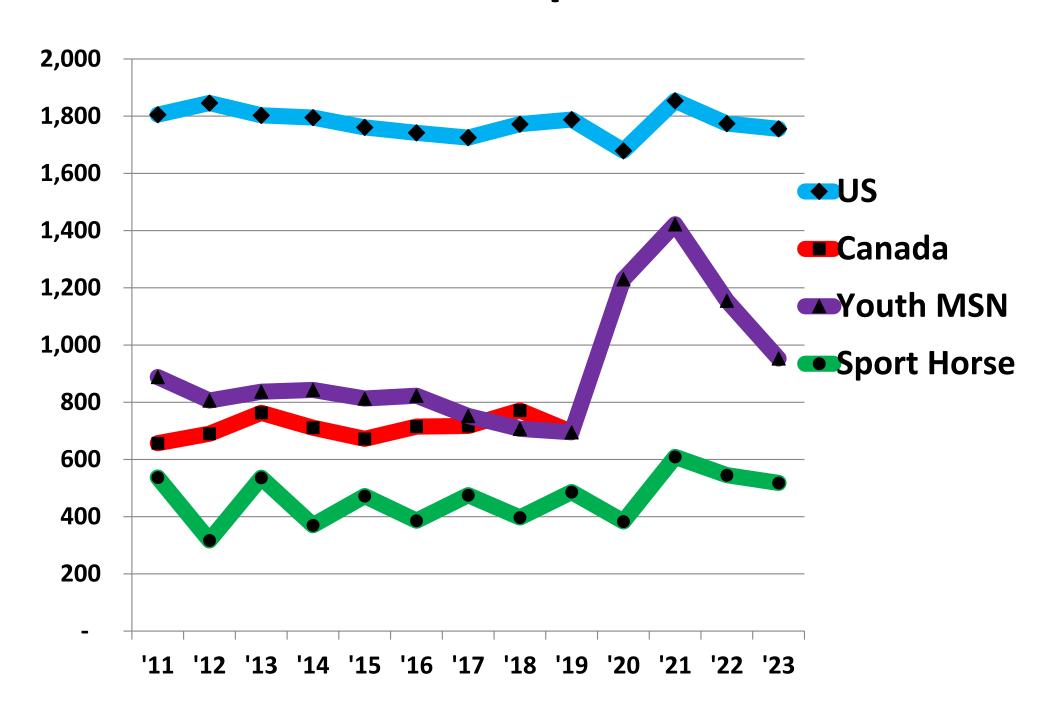

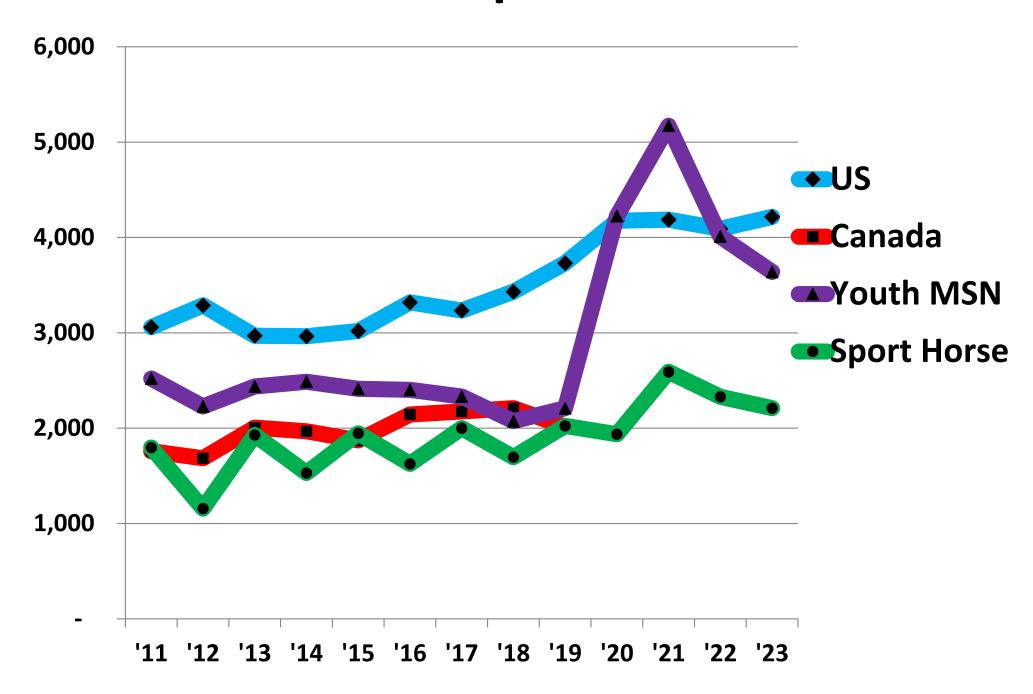
