22 Whereas, Not all Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian stallions are Sport Horses, and

24 Whereas, Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian stallions may show in performance classes, and

26 Whereas, In the opinion of the proponent, Performance Halter may be an excellent avenue to show Half-
27 Arabian/Anglo-Arabian stallions and Performance Halter rules, AR123, refer to subchapter 3 (Half-
28 Arabian/Anglo-Arabian Breeding/Gelding In-Hand); Therefore, Be It

30 Resolved, That USEF AR122.3 AR124.3 be amended by inserting the following:

32 3. Classes for Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian colts/stallions may be offered for horses one year of age and over. Half-
33 Arabian/Anglo-Arabian stallions must not enter classes offered for geldings. (Exception: HA/AA Stallions may enter
34 classes for HA/AA Halter geldings only if no stallion class is offered and the horse is a yearling or younger.)
35 3. For Half Arabian/Anglo Arabian Performance Halter for colt/stallion, filly/mare and gelding classes emphasis is placed
36 in the following order: athletic structure, quality, balance and substance, neck and shoulder, back, loin and hip, legs and
37 feet, and movement.
