Whereas, Some of the AHA Dressage and Western Dressage Committee members desire to more closely follow USEF Dressage rules, and

Whereas, Concern has been voiced by these committee members and Dressage judges that our horses are shown in too many Dressage classes per day and it negatively affects the horses' overall well-being; Therefore, Be It

Resolved, That USEF AR172.6 be amended by striking out the following:

6. Entries must comply with DR119.2 (Exception: ~~Horses competing at AHA Regional and National Championship competitions are not limited to a maximum of three Dressage rides per day at Fourth Level or below.~~ Horses competing in Intro Level classes at the AHA Youth National Championship may enter three levels at that competition only.), and; Be It Further

Resolved, That USEF AR172.9 be amended by striking out:

~~9. Dressage horses competing at USEF Licensed Arabian competitions are not limited to a maximum of three rides per day at Fourth Level or below. (Exception: open Dressage classes or divisions.)~~, and; Be It Further

Resolved, That the remaining subparagraph(s) be re-numbered.
