19 Whereas, Due to COVID-19, USEF issued a presidential modification changing the procedure for jogging
20 for soundness at the conclusion of jumping rounds in the working hunter sections, and
21
22 Whereas, Exhibitors preferred this new procedure because it does not require the stripping of tack, and tacking up the
23 horse to complete the under saddle portion, and

25 Whereas, Show management preferred this new procedure because it proved to be an immense time saver; Therefore,
26 Be It

28 Resolved, That USEF AR159.5 be amended by striking out and inserting the following:

30 All horses must be serviceably sound (See HU 121). All horses being considered for an award must jog for soundness
31 ~~with the rider dismounted~~ (Exception: Under Saddle classes, Working Hunter classes with specifications that do not
32 require horses to jog, local or unrated classes). ~~Horses must return to the ring for soundness wearing an acceptable~~
33 ~~approved bridle.~~ ***Horses are required to trot a circle on a loose rein at the end of each over fences performance.***
