

Supreme Champion Pattern



Grandstands

Horses will enter the ring in back number order.

Judging begins when the horse enters the ring.

The horse will enter at a walk through what is commonly used as the Out-Gate to the first marker then pick up the trot.

Halt at the second marker for judging conformation.

In order to satisfy a proper presentation to the judges, horses should be shown in an "open position," with horse's head and neck in a natural and comfortable carriage.

Following the evaluation by the judges, horses shall walk away from the judges, and then strike a trot at the third marker and trot to the end of the arena and lineup.

The score cards will be completed by the judges, turned in and the next horse will enter the ring for evaluation.
