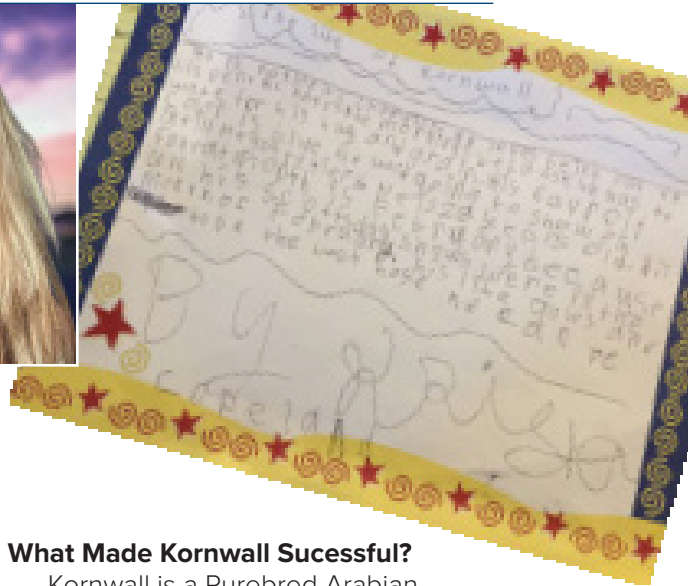
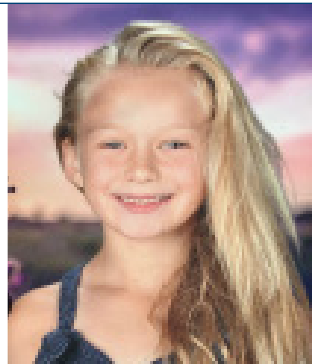


## SHORT STORY:

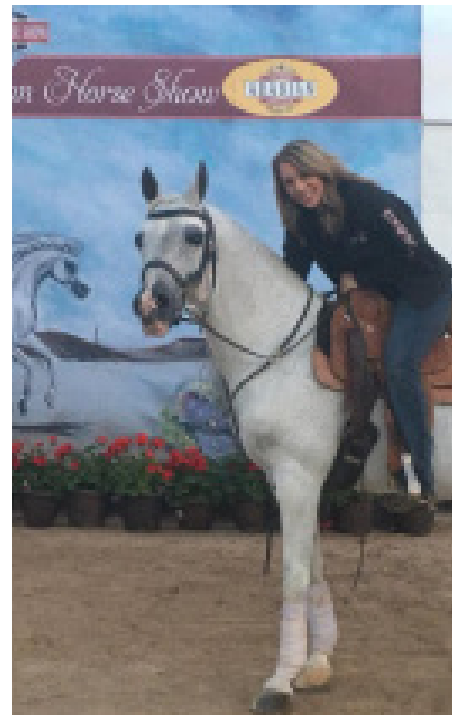
